Darrell Purchase; City of Oakland Park Code Enforcement Officer

It was a very busy quart (January to March) with 187 Action Orders, and 172 cases opened. January and February were busy due to the new bulk and trash pickup. Residents putting trash out on wrong days or out more than 48hr ahead of time. Refer to the Talk Trash hand book for the pickup days in your area

Trash and your Recycling should be place in the proper location no earlier then the night before or morning of by 7am on the designated collection days. Trash cans and Recycle bins must be removed from the front of your home the same day after pick up. Bulk Trash items must be placed at the Curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the first Monday of the collection week. It maybe place at the curb up to 48hr ahead of the pickup date (Monday) But no earlier than the Saturdays before. Please check Talk Trash hand book for your week for bulk or call 954-630-4452 see attachment for Talk Trash handbook

While there may be no limit as to how many cars you have, cars cannot be parked in your front yard on the Grass. They must be parked on a permitted paved surfaces, gravel in not a permitted parking. Parking on the swales in front of your own home is permissible. You cannot park on someone else's swale without their permission. You are also obligated to maintain the Grass on your swale you cannot change it to gravel or pave it. Any planting in swale must be permitted. The Community ordinance regarding storage outside of your home took affect March 1. While the ordinance for Recreational, Commercial Vehicle was tabled for further discussions.

Tammy Moore; South Florida Water Management District,

Indicated that All of South Florida is under water restrictions, [Broward County](#) passed an ordinance in 2010, adopting year round irrigation restrictions. As a part of this [ordinance](#), it enacted a landscape irrigation schedule allowing residences and businesses with an odd-numbered street address to water lawns and landscapes on Wednesdays and/or Saturdays, only before 10:00 a.m. or after 4:00 p.m. only. Residences and businesses with an even-numbered street address, no street address, or those who irrigate both even and odd addresses within the same zones, which may include multi-family units and homeowners associations, may water lawns and landscapes on Thursdays and/or Sundays, only before 10:00 a.m. or after 4:00 p.m. only. **Absolutely no watering on Fridays.**

The water shortage is being taken seriously; they have a surveillance team now going around by car and helicopters, looking for violators.

Sink Aerators and Flyer with information about conserving our drinking water was handed out.

Q: I water my lawn from a well, canal, pond or surface lake. Do these restrictions apply to me?

A: Yes. Surface and groundwater sources are connected so removing water from one source affects the others. Water in lakes and canals helps to protect private and public wells from saltwater intrusion, and stores rainfall to recharge wells and aquifers. Find out more go to <http://www.sfwmd.gov>
